

Privacy Policy

Grindabit Interactive, Inc., including Grindabuck and all other related entities and businesses (collectively, Grindabit) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the websites www.grindabit.com and www.grindabuck.com (our Websites) and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- on our Websites; and
- in e-mail, text and other electronic messages between you and our Websites; and

It does not apply to information collected by:

- us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by Grindabit or any third party; or
- any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on our Websites.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Websites. By accessing or using our Websites, you agree to this Privacy Policy. This policy may change from time to time, as described below. Your continued use of our Websites after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 13

Our Websites are not intended for children under 13 years of age. No one under age 13 may provide any personal information to or on the Websites. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, do not use or provide any information on this Website or on or through any of its features. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

Grindabit may collect information about you, including personal information, when you use various parts of our Websites. You can engage in many activities as part of the services we offer without providing any personal information. However, certain activities such as setting up an account with us, using our offer walls, making a cash-out request or subscribing to our newsletters or publications, may require you to provide personal information. You may be asked to provide certain personal information when you sign up for our services or publications or for account verification. Such personal information may include, without limitation:

- Information by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, copies of personal identification documents (e.g., drivers' license) or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("personal information");
- Information that is about you but individually does not identify you; and/or
- Information about your internet connection, such as IP address, the equipment you use to access our Website and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through our Websites. Information collected automatically may include usage details, the type of computer and browser being used to access the Websites, IP addresses and information collected through cookies and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Websites may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Websites. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our Websites, subscribing to newsletters or publications, posting material, requesting product information or support. We may also ask you for information when you enter a contest or promotion sponsored by us, and when you report a problem with our Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including e-mail addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that you might decide to complete (e.g., offer wall surveys).
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Websites and of the fulfillment of your orders and other requests. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Websites.

You also may provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "posted") on public areas of the Website, or transmitted to other users of the Website or third parties (collectively, "User Contributions"). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Although we limit access to certain pages, please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of the Website with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

Information We Collect Automatically

As you navigate through and interact with our Websites, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking). See below for information on how you can opt out of behavioral tracking on this website and how we respond to web browser signals and other mechanisms that enable consumers to exercise choice about behavioral tracking.

The information we collect automatically is statistical data and does not include personal information. This information helps us to improve our Website and to deliver better and more personalized features to you, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include cookies. A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting, you may be unable to access certain parts of our Websites. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Websites.

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Websites and their contents to you.
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us.
- To confirm your identity and location as part of the account set-up process.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Websites or any products or services we offer or provide through it.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on our Websites.

- For the purpose of aggregated statistical analysis of how you and others use our Websites and our products.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may also use your information to contact you about our own and third-parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you. If you do not want us to use your information in this way, please check the relevant box located on the form on which we collect your data. Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution or other sale or transfer of some or all of Grindabit' assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Grindabit about users of our Websites is among the assets transferred.
- To third parties to market their products or services to you if you have consented to these disclosures.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms of Use and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.

- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Grindabit, our customers or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Our Commitment to Data Security

International Users

- Right to restriction of processing: You have the right to request the limiting of our processing under limited circumstances, including: when the accuracy of your personal information is contested; when the processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of your personal information and request the restriction of the use of your personal information instead; or when you have objected to processing pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of Grindabit override your grounds.
